



## July DE New Ruies 2020

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The following are the step by-step instructions mandated by Le Circuit and Public Health Authorities for the July DE. The health and safety of everyone will be the primary consideration.

### **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY, PRINT, BRING A COPY AND FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIVES.**

1. **PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE EVENT IF;** You have Covid-19 symptoms, been in contact with someone in the last 2 weeks who has been sick or is asymptomatic. (request a refund).
2. Rennsport is responsible for ensuring its members adhere to Public Health and Le Circuit mandated safety protocols. Rennsport Leadership and Track Chair have the authority to require you to leave if you cannot comply with these community protection measures.
3. PCA Waivers: Before leaving for the DE, please electronically sign the PCA Event Waiver and Communicable Disease Waivers on ClubRegistration.net. Please follow the directions in the email you received.
4. **Please print, sign and bring to the track, the following documents:** Tech Inspection Form, LeCircuit event waiver. Note your assigned run group as you will be asked at Registration. Please logon to the [www.Rennsport.ca](http://www.Rennsport.ca) and use these links in The DE Info Tab

5. Have your car Tech Inspected and make sure you have pre-signed the form prior to arrival.
6. **NEW TRACK ARRIVAL PROCESS.**
  - a. On Monday morning enter by the Karting entrance on Chemin du Village by 7:00 am. Proceed to the registration Tent/trailer to provide your signed LCMT Track waiver and obtain the correct bracelets. NO bracelets=NO ENTRY. Chemin Séguin entrance will ONLY accept participants with bracelets.
  - b. **Make sure you have a pen and a mask**, none will be provided at registration.
  - c. Only 1 person in the registration trailer at a time. Maintain 2 meter social distancing and wear your mask while waiting in line for entry to the trailer.
  - d. Deposit your signed track waivers in the appropriate boxes.
  - e. Obtain your run group and track bracelets. You will be asked your run group & given a bracelet by a masked & gloved attendant.
  - f. Have a squirt of hand sanitizer & return to your car through the open exit door.
  - g. If you are not able to register on Monday morning please contact [DrivingEvents@Rennsport.ca](mailto:DrivingEvents@Rennsport.ca) to make alternative arrangements.
7. Put your wristbands on and then drive to the paddock via the in field road to turn 1. Cross the track to the paddock. Show the attendant your wristband.
8. **Immediately** prep your car for on track use; numbers on, cleaned out and ready to go.
9. **Put on your mask** and go through the Tech Line. Stay in your car and deposit your signed Tech Form in the box provided. Go to your chosen parking spot.
10. The mandatory Drivers meeting will take place at exactly 8:15 am at the base of the tower. You must maintain social distancing of 2 meters at ALL times. The wearing of a face covering is highly recommended. Please have your Instruction email in hand so you can follow along.
11. **SUNDAY TRAILER DROP-OFF, PROCEDURES** - Participants must obtain permission from Circuit Mont Tremblant management prior to dropping their trailer in advance of an event. Arrival times will be between 17 :00-20:00 via rue Séguin. Drop-off will be defined as unhook and go, no set up, no socializing, no loitering. To obtain permission please provide your drop off time and names of persons arriving with the trailer to [President@Rennsport.ca](mailto:President@Rennsport.ca) no later than noon July 17, 2020. **You must then follow step 6 on Monday morning.**



## July DE New Rules

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The following are **NEW rules** applicable to the July DE. **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!**

1. IF YOU START TO FEEL SICK while at the track, notify Rennsport Safety Chair or Track Chair and go home. A noncontact infrared forehead thermometer will be available for testing. Rennsport must report any participants or guests who feel sick to Circuit Mont Tremblant Management
2. Paddock SPACES The circuit reserves the right to pre-designate paddock spaces and other areas.
3. Paddock COMPOUNDS The paddock will be divided into compounds for teams and individual participants.
4. Paddock PARKING - your truck/trailer/awning must have a minimum distance of 5 meters (15ft) between the next nearest participants' truck/trailer/awning set up.
5. Paddock CLOSURE The paddock will be closed to participants after 19:00.
6. ALL PARTICIPANTS, HELPERS and GUESTS- Must wear a protective face mask, when venturing outside their own designated paddock space, visiting the restrooms and/or whenever a 2 meter (6ft) separation is not possible.
7. RESTROOMS will be closed upon arrival.
8. RESTROOM FACILITIES AT CONTROL TOWER - will be open to one (1) person at a time. You will be required to wear a face mask. Follow posted directions, sanitary procedures and respect social distancing guidelines at all times. Restrooms will close at 19:00.
9. ALL PARTICIPANTS, HELPERS AND GUESTS- are discouraged from roaming the paddock and/or socializing with others without practicing social distancing.
10. CAMPING RVs - MOTORHOMES / RVs / TRAVEL TRAILERS - MOTORHOMES / RVs / TRAVEL TRAILERS - will be accepted in the paddock as of July 6, 2020 for confirmed registered participants. Overnight security will be in place for those intending to stay overnight in the paddock either the night before an event, the nights between multiple day events or following an event if prearranged with Circuit Mont-Tremblant. Permission must be received in advance from Circuit Mont-Tremblant management and participants must submit the name(s) and signed ACCEPTANCE OF RISK waiver of each person staying in the unit 2 days in advance. We will accept either a scan or .pdf of this document (no photo) by email only no later than July 17, 2020. Please send your email to [President@Rennsport.ca](mailto:President@Rennsport.ca) Waivers will not be accepted at the gate. Participants and/or guests who have not registered in advance will not be permitted entry.

Motorhomes / RVs / Travel Trailers will be permitted entry from 18:00pm to 20:00pm unless otherwise prearranged with Circuit Mont-Tremblant. Gates to the paddock will close at 7:00pm each night unless prearranged with Circuit Mont-Tremblant.

Motorhomes / RVs / Travel Trailers must be self-contained and equipped with a washroom. Restroom facilities at Circuit Mont-Tremblant will close at 5:00pm each day.

Overnight occupation is limited only to persons who reside at the same address. Any gathering is limited to a maximum of 10 persons from a maximum of three (3) households. A minimum physical distance of 2 meters (6ft) must be maintained between people who do not come from the same household otherwise the number of guests must be reduced.

Wearing masks is required when it is not possible to maintain a distance of 2 meters (6ft) with other people.

11. NO PETS - No pets are permitted.



12. GUESTS – Are permitted and must sign the LCMT track, PCA event and PCA Communicable Disease waivers and obtain the correct bracelet. Guests MUST register in person on Monday between 07:00 and 0800.
13. GROUP MEETINGS SPACES – group meetings are not permitted unless they respect social distancing rules.
14. TRASH/GARBAGE – No trash bins, everyone must take their trash with them at end of day.
15. CAFETERIA/FOOD/WATER – The cafeteria will be closed to walk up service. Communal food and WATER are NOT PERMITTED in the paddock and/or administration tent .We recommend you bring your lunch and water for the day or make arrangements with Milly's at <http://millys.ca>.
16. Social distancing, the wearing of masks will be enforced at the track. Access to the tower will be closed.
17. TIRE SERVICE - Touchette tire service will be available.
18. IN CAR COACHING – not permitted.
19. EVENING SOCIAL EVENT – NO evening social due to social distancing regulations.
20. PADDOCK ACCESS - restricted to drivers, partner support personnel and registered guests ONLY.
