## **DE Obligatory Checklist – see below for details**

- Electric and Hybrid vehicles are not permitted at events held at Le Circuit Mont Tremblant and Calabogie Motorsports Park.
- Registration and payment completed no later than 7 days prior to the event.
- All waivers have been signed electronically in ClubRegistration.net
- You are confirmed by the Registrar
- Car Inspection no more than 3 weeks prior to the event
- Printed & Signed Tech inspection sheet
- SNELL or FIA8859 Homologation approved helmet
- Your car meets PCA DE minimum Standards
- Installed tow hook
- First morning of event; install car numbers and tow hook, empty loose items in car, remove driver side floor mats, proceed to Tech-Line with your helmet and Head Neck Restraint Device (if applicable) (07:00-8:15)



## Registration before event

- Registration is via the ClubRegistration web site www.clubregistration.net
- IMPORTANT Due to Le Circuit Mont Tremblant track restrictions Electric and Hybrid vehicles will *NOT* be permitted at Le Circuit Mont Tremblant HPDE events.
- Registration and payment (via PayPal) must be completed no later than 7 days before the event date.
- Please note registration for an event closes 7 calendar days before the event.
- Registration and payment does guarantee attendance. You can attend the event ONLY when confirmed by the registrar.

- Rennsport events are open to BMW brand vehicles IF the driver is signed off solo from a Rennsport recognized driving club i.e.: BMW QC, Virages, Club Tremblant
- Car numbers are assigned by the registrar and confirmed in the event roaster available on ClubRegistration.net. Car numbers are valid for all events.

### Refund Policy

No refunds unless cancelled a minimum of 2 weeks before the closure of registration. Cancellation must be performed via clubregistration.net

### Track Registration

Track registration opens the first day of the event at 7:00 am and closes at 8:30. No exceptions. Please ensure you arrive early.

### PCA DE Minimum Standards

Drivers responsible for ensuring they and their cars meet PCA DE minimum standards. They are available at <u>https://www.pca.org/drivers-education/Drivers-Education-Minimum-Standard</u>

• Long pants and lace up shoes are required. Avoid synthetic materials. 100% cotton



and/or "Nomex" garments are recommended. Sleeved shirts are mandatory.

- Similar safety system (Seats, harness, roll bar, installation etc.) must be available for both driver and passenger.
- Only an instructor or their student may be a passenger in a car. Participants must be 18 years old or more and have a valid driver's license.

# Before attending the DE

## Vehicle Technical inspection

A Technical Inspection must be performed specific to each event, within 3 weeks of the event date by a Rennsport authorized Technical Inspection center.

- List of authorized Technical Inspection centers DE Info tab on www.rennsport.ca
- They will inspect your car and complete the Rennsport Technical Inspection sheet. It must be signed by the registrant and provided to the Tech-line supervisor on the first morning of the event.

### Tow Hooks

The use of an easily accessible **Tow Hook is mandatory**. **Please ensure your tow hooks are installed before proceeding to the Tech-line each morning**.

### Car window requirements

Cars must permit car windows to be in the down position to permit point by signals. Cars not supporting this function will be banned from track and drivers will not be refunded.

### **R** Compound Tires

"R" Compound Tires or semi-slicks are only permitted in the Blue, Black and Red run groups.

### Car Numbers

Assigned by the registrar and applicable for all events. Numbers to be provided by the participant and must be of contrasting color, a minimum of 6 inches high and placed on both sides of the car.

Must be installed prior to going to the Tech-line inspection.

# Fire Extinguisher

Fire extinguishers are RECOMMENDED for Rennsport events. Please see PCA HPDE Minimum Standards for mounting details.

PACC (Porsche Active Cruise Control) PAS (Porsche Active Safety)



Vehicles fitted with a Collision Avoidance System and Porsche Active Safety System must have a means of 100% defeating the system. Upon request, this defeat function must be demonstrated to Tech-Line personnel. It is the responsibility of participants to ensure their vehicle can comply with this requirement.

Participants must ensure it is deactivated each time they go on track. Cars not supporting this function will not be permitted on track.

### Helmet safety rule

ONLY SNELL SA/SM2015-2020 or their equivalent FIA (8859 Homologated) BSI and SFI certified helmets will be permitted.

Real time Timing / coaching devices

DE's are NOT timed events and NOT race practices. All timing and timing devices are strictly forbidden.

#### Mandatory morning Tech-line Inspection

All drivers MUST have their car inspected each morning between 07:00 and 8:15. If you are late, you must find the Tech-line Leader and have your car inspected at his convenience. You may loose a morning session.

You are requested to bring your helmet to the Tech-line for inspection. A compliance sticker will be affixed to your helmet.

#### Mandatory Drivers meeting

All drivers MUST attend the daily drivers meeting at 8:15.

#### Dommages au circuit - Track Damages

Drivers responsible for track damages are financially liable for said damages. Drivers agree to reimburse Rennsport for all track damages they cause, no later than 60 days after issuance of a damage invoice.

#### <u>Guests</u>

All Drivers are responsible for their guests. Drivers are responsible for ensuring their guests have pre-registered for the event, completed and signed all waivers.

#### Work assignments

Participants may have a work assignment during each event. Any participant who is late or fails to perform their work assignment will be penalized.



## Drugs and Alcohol

The use of drugs is strictly prohibited. No alcohol open on the site until after 5 PM. Do not consume alcohol at lunch if off site.

# Track photos images and video

Photos, images and video footage of an accident are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED and CANNOT** be posted on any Social Media.

Participants agree to use photos, images and video footage responsibly in accordance with local, provincial, and federal privacy laws.

Personal information in all images and recordings MUST be removed prior to any posting on social media platforms.

All images and recordings are for personal use **ONLY and cannot be used for direct or indirect commercial purposes.** The participant of any such accident related posts shall be liable to pay Le Circuit the amounts for liquidated damages as defined in the contract between Rennsport and Le Circuit Mont-Tremblant.

# Use of Drones

The use of UAVs (also known as drones) at the Track, the Other Facilities, and anywhere on the property of the race is track is STRICKLY PROHIBITED. Any individual refusing to suspend UAV usage maybe expulsed from the event at the sole discretion of event organizers.

The UAV operator shall be held responsible for any and all damages caused directly or indirectly by the use of a UAV.

### LCMT Noise limite

Tremblant has adopted a noise limit restriction not to exceed 92dB SPL measured track side at 50 feet. It's the driver's responsibility to conform to the restriction and any car judged to exceed the limit may not be allowed to participate. There are no refunds should a car be excluded for excessive noise.

- Appropriate clothing to accommodate changing weather i.e.; Rain gear
- Printed & Signed Tech inspection sheet
- SNELL approved helmet
- Water, sunglasses , cap or hat, sun screen
- Additional oil, coolant, brake fluid
- Paper towels or shop rags
- Tire pressure gauge
- Glass cleaner
- Folding chair (optional)
- Trap or Protective cover for car items
- Umbrella / sun shade
- First morning of event; install car numbers and tow hook, empty loose items in car, remove driver side floor mat, proceed to Tech-line with your helmet and HNR Device (if applicable) (07:00-8:15)
